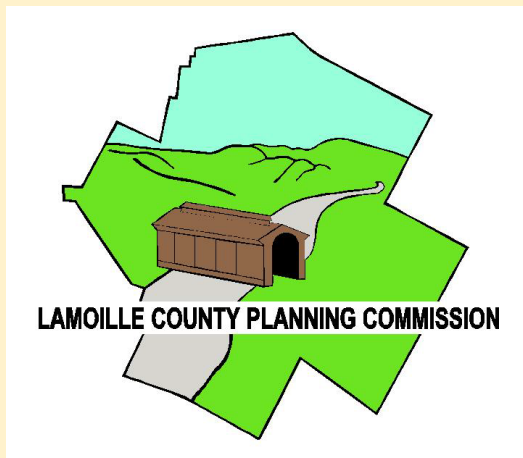
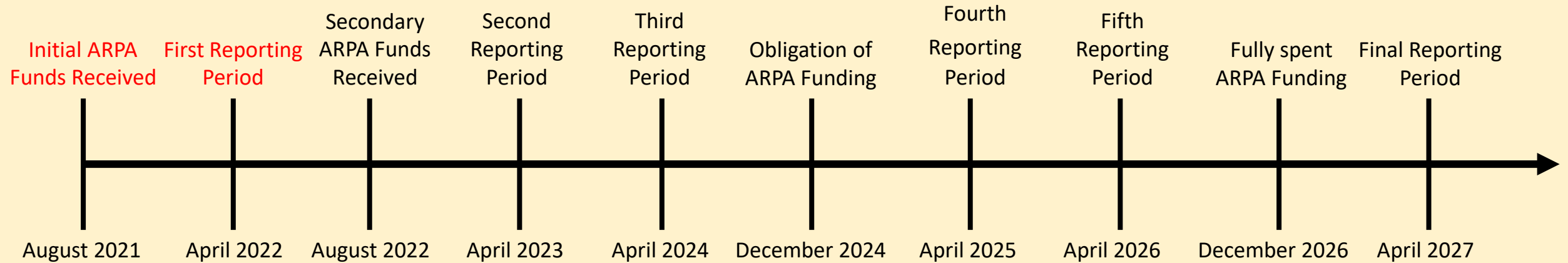

Important Timelines



Final Rule Overview

- Took effect April 1st, 2022.
- Broadens project eligibility
- Implemented the Standard Allowance; towns can take full allocation up to \$10 million under revenue replacement.



Standard Allowance

- All 15 Towns and Villages elected to take the Standard Allowance.
- Allows recipients to use full amount of the award (up to \$10 million) for “Provision of Government Services”
- Your ARPA funds can be used on anything you would take in front of your voters.

Provision of Government Services

Your ARPA funds can be used on any service traditionally provided by a local government.

These can include but are not limited to:

- Water/wastewater infrastructure
- Broadband
- Municipal buildings energy efficiency upgrades
- Municipal buildings IT upgrades
- Match for Federal and Non-Federal programs



Statewide Programs

ACCD, Agency of Natural Resources, and Vermont Emergency Management have various ARPA programs aimed to assist towns



Town/Village Projects being discussed by Communities

Cambridge Village- Replacement of the village pumphouse roof.

Jeffersonville Village- Replaced old/damaged water meters.

Wolcott- Upgrades to Town office technology for telework and upgrades to the Wolcott town website.

Hyde Park- Town office technology upgrades for digitizing public records, stormwater improvements on Church & Main streets, and water system upgrades for Hyde Park Fire District 1.
