**LVRT Presentation by Jackie Casino**

- Jackie Casino gave a presentation on the LVRT with updates and future plans
- LVRT 12 will be completed by February 2023
- LVRT 14 signage project will begin in Spring 2023
- Wayfinding signs will be on State and Town roads. Town signs already in place will not need to be replaced
- Speed limit of e bikes was brought up and VTrans currently does not have plans to enforce a speed limit due to lack of data
- LVRT Council: This can be a subcommittee of TAC or citizens committee, whichever suites the county the best. This committee is meant to act the first point of contact for VTrans when discussing LVRT policies/projects within Lamoille County
- VTrans plans to hold 2 annual meetings where each region LVRT Council will come together
- Trail friendly business signs will come later
- LVRT Community Grant Program: 20% match, \$2 million available in total funds

- TAC should advance the idea of the LVRT council to the LCPC Board of Directors to gain further guidance
